

# Regulations for Compulsory Product certification Mark of CEMC

## 1 Objective

The following regulations are constituted for implementation based on "Regulations for Certificate and Certification Mark (2004 as the AQSIQ order No.63) "and "Regulations for Compulsory Product Certification Mark (2001 as the CNCA announcement No.1)" to strengthen administration governing the compulsory product certification mark (hereinafter referred to as Certification Mark) so as to ensure a correct use of Certification Mark and safeguard the legitimate rights and interests of the consumers.

## 2 Scope

These regulations are applicable to the Certification Mark corresponding to the 3C certificate issued by CEMC.

3 The design of the Certification Mark, the use of the Certification Mark, the production, application and grant of the Certification Mark are referred to "Regulations for Compulsory Product Certification Mark (2001 as the CNCA announcement No.1)".

4 Certificate holder shall abide by the following requirements:

- 1) To set up a management system in the use of the Certification Mark, and to keep a true and complete file in the use of the Certification Mark.
- 2) To ensure that product with the Certification Mark meets the certification criteria.
- 3) Should the certified products fail to meet certification criteria within the validity period of the certification, the CEMC shall request the applicant to take corrective action within a prescribed time period, and no Certification Mark is allowed for use during this time period.
- 4) No Certification Mark is permitted to use for product when the certification has expired.
- 5) To ensure a correct use of the Certification Mark in promotional materials, such as any advertising or leaflet of the products, so that the consumers are not misguided or cheated.
- 6) To accept the supervision and check in the use of the Certification Mark by CEMC.

## 5 Penalties

5.1 Administrative penalties will be imposed for any of the following irregular practices. If violation of Criminal Law is involved, legal action will be taken accordingly.

- 1) Falsification, modification, trading or transfer of the Certification Marks.
- 2) To seize and hold in possession the Certification Mark without approval.
- 3) To use the certification mark under another party name. or
- 4) Other illegal practices contrary to these regulations as well as AQSIQ and CNCA regulations.

6 Application, cost and charge paying, and the design documented of the Certification Mark.

6.1 Certification holder shall transact the application, cost and charge paying, and the design documented of the Certification Mark in the CCC Certification Mark Granting Administration Center.
